

Ohio CCW Recertification Classes

For individuals with valid Ohio CCW licenses which are expiring (up for renewal) in 2008, D&D Firearms Instructors, LLC is offering 4-hour recertification classes which extend your classroom training renewal date by six (6) years. This is not a mandatory class since many license holders will have two (2) years remaining on the original CCW class training requirements.

The **BENEFIT** of renewing your classroom training requirements now is that keeping track of the two types of renewals is easy: when it's time to renew your license, it's time to renew your training! If your training renewal date expires even with a valid license, you'll have to take the 12-hour certification class all over again before the next CCW license renewal.

When you complete the recertification class you will receive a certificate of training good for six (6) years. Take this certificate along with a passport photo, fill out another application and after being fingerprinted again, you'll pick up your new license within a few weeks. The license renewal fee is \$55 and will be good for five (5) years.

The **PRICE** of the recertification class will be **\$80**.

The recertification class will teach you:

- Safe handling of firearms and ammunition.
- Laws pertaining to Ohio CCW.
- Laws pertaining to self defense
- LIABILITY issues.
- Mechanics of handgun shooting, including loading and unloading.

There will be a written test and a live fire test just like the original class only this time the classroom training is two (2) hours with two (2) hours of range time.

CLASS REQUIREMENTS

1. Must have valid Ohio CCW license expiring in 2008.
2. Handgun can only be of the following calibers: 32, 380, 38, 9mm, 357 SIG, 38 Super, 40, 45 GAP/ACP.
3. Bring firearm the day of class WITH HOLSTER designed for your handgun.
4. Autos require 2 magazines and speed loaders for revolvers would be helpful.
5. 150 rounds of ammo—NO RELOADS.
6. Eye and ear protection.
